


EXAM INTERFACE

The exam interface consists three tabs which contain:

- test scenario
- exam questions
- exam application you can open application in new tab and use second screen

During the exam, you can freely navigate between the tabs without losing your current results and the selected answers.




The scenario provides basic information about the application that you will be testing during the exam. In each question you will receive various types of commands related to the tested application.

Clicking on the symbol 📝 appearing in the questions, refers directly to the part of the application, that the question relates.

If you have done the tests in the application tab, scrolling up the screen lets you return to the questions tab.

The "Reset" button located below application, allows deleting entered data. This way, the app can be restored to its initial state and you can test it from scratch if necessary.



Resetting the application does not reset the answers already given.



EXAM QUESTIONS

The application, questions and their order are generated randomly.

The exam tasks consist opened and closed questions with one (radio) or several (check box) correct answers (details in the chapter 3).

For each question, you can get from 1 to 3 points. The number of achievable points is marked for each question. If you answer incorrectly, you will not receive a point.







EXAM QUESTIONS
